Health Care Position Description – 2010

Camp Kingsmont is required to comply with the 'Minimum Standards for Recreational Camps for Children (State Sanitary Code, Chapter IV)' 105 CMR 430.000 et seq. As such, we are obligated to retain a health care consultant and to provide a full time health care supervisor.

The health care consultant must be a Massachusetts licensed physician, nurse practitioner or physician assistant with pediatric training who will assist in development of the camp's health care policies, approve any changes to the camp policies, review and approve the first aid training of the staff, be available for consultation at all times and develop and sign written orders to be followed by the on-site health supervisor in the administration of their health related duties.

We are obligated to have a health supervisor at camp 24 hours every day from June 20 to August 14, 2010. The health care supervisor must be a Massachusetts licensed physician, nurse, nurse practitioner, physician assistant or licensed practical nurse.

Meals and lodging will be provided. In addition to handling day to day first aid and other health situations, the health supervisor must care for and administer daily medications to campers, must review and approve individual camper and staff immunization forms and other required health paperwork and maintain required medical records. All campers and staff must be screened within 24 hours of arrival at camp.

The health supervisor will maintain regular clinic hours daily and will be available via walkie talkie or phone at all other times while on duty. The health supervisor will dine with the campers and staff and will sleep above the clinic in a dorm room. The suite of rooms has a small kitchen and common area. The health supervisor will be responsible for maintaining the clinic, for inventory of all medical supplies and for referrals to the health care consultant or other medical personnel as the need arises.
